Black History Month

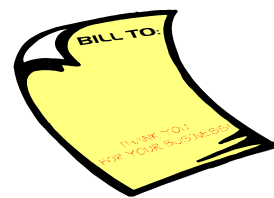
Black History Month, or National African American History Month, is an annual celebration of achievements by black Americans and a time for recognizing the central role of African Americans in U.S. history. The event grew out of "Negro History Week," the brainchild of noted historian Carter G. Woodson and other prominent African Americans. Since 1976, every U.S. president has officially designated the month of February as Black History Month.

Reminders:

Morning Care / Academic Enrichment Payments:



February payment is due by the 10th of the month. All additional payments are also due on the 10th of each month. A late fee will be applied to any payment received after the 10th of that month.

Morning care fees: \$95.00 per month or \$15.00 per day. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:30 am for this program. Breakfast is included.

Academic Enrichment Program fees: \$165.00 per month or \$25.00 per day. Snack is provided along with homework help, tutoring when needed, an educational activity and some recess time.
