Did you Know?

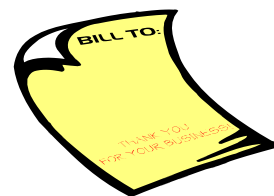
Cinco de Mayo is celebrated on May 5th both in Mexico, mainly in Pueblo, and in the U.S. Both countries have different origins for their reasons for celebrating this day. In Mexico, this holiday celebrates the Battle of Pueblo in the state of Pueblo, which ended on May 5th, 1862 with the Mexican army defeating the French.

In the U.S. Cinco de Mayo began as a celebration to commemorate freedom and democracy, Mexican heritage and pride. It began in the American West, by Mexican-American communities during the American Civil War.



Reminders:

Morning Care / Academic Enrichment Payments:



May payment is due by the 10th of the month. All additional payments are also due on the 10th of each month. A late fee will be applied to any payment received after the 10th of that month.

Morning care fees: \$95.00 per month or \$15.00 per day. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:30 am for this program. Breakfast is included.

Academic Enrichment Program fees: \$165.00 per month or \$25.00 per day. Snack is provided along with homework help, tutoring when needed, an educational activity and some recess time. Students must be picked up no later than 6:00 pm. Any student not picked up by 6:00 pm, a \$25.00 fee will be charged plus \$1.00 per minute after that.
