Attendance

Parents it is imperative that you arrive to school on time. Students are tardy after 8:30 am. <u>The parent must escort the child</u> to the front office and sign them in. If your child is sick please call the office.

Uniforms



Morning Care/STAR
(Supplemental Tutoring and
Reading) Payments:



September payment is due by the 5th of the month. All additional payments are also due on the 5th of each month. A late fee will be applied to any payment received after the 10th of that month.

Morning care fees: \$95.00 per month or \$15.00 per day. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:30 am for this program.

Breakfast is included.

STAR Program fees: \$165.00 per month or \$25.00 per day. Snack is provided along with homework help, tutoring when needed, an educational activity and some recess time.
